Last year, Jessica hit the road with country legend Jo Dee Messina for a west coast tour and also had the honour of opening for country music icon Loretta Lynn in August. Her high-energy and dynamic live show has garnered rave reviews from critics everywhere calling her a "Rocket Force," and 2016 saw her on her third national and first international tour in Canada and Europe. She released her first official music video and single "Not Your Woman" in 2016 and her debut self-titled EP was released on June 21, 2016. 2017 will take Jessica and the band around the world once again with a busy tour schedule that includes a date in France to open for iconic rockers ZZ Top.

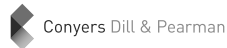
