TIPS FOR WATCHING THE SHOW

In some theatrical performances, it is polite to wait until the end of the act to applaud. Not in this show! The performers feed off your energy and love to hear your laughs and cheers throughout the show. If you feel the urge to laugh out loud, don't hold back!

MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

Can you name all the musical instruments and references? Try to list them after the show.

CHOREOGRAPHY

Watch how the performers choreograph the movement of their bodies and props to the music. How are the moves similar and different from dancing?

COLOURS

Colours are an important theme throughout the show. Pay attention to how the colours are used to tell a story and highlight each character.

MULTITASKING

Many of the acts combine multiple skills at the same time, including juggling, music, balancing and more. What combinations do you notice? What skills can you do at the same time?

PHYSICAL COMEDY

Not all jokes use words. The performers use their faces, bodies and props to share their playfulness and laughter with the audience. Can you make your friends laugh without saying a word?

AFTER THE SHOW

Use your creativity and talents to support your community! Playing By Air's performers love to make people laugh. They perform regularly in hospitals and use their talents to support charities. You don't have to be a professional entertainer to give back to your community. Do you like to draw? Jump rope? Tell stories? Play an instrument?
