# Biography

**Heather Nova** grew up in Bermuda. After graduating from the Rhode Island School of Design in 1990, she moved to London with her guitar and a demo tape in hand, and has been making records and touring extensively ever since. She has had chart success on both sides of the Atlantic, has sold over 2 million albums, and has had her songs featured in film and TV. She will release her 10th studio album in May.

Tonight she gives us an acoustic performance, combining a selection of her own material, with songs by other female artists. Unique to this show, Heather will give us a look behind her writing process, and will share personal stories about her songs.

As part of her show, Heather will invite the winner of the young songwriters competition, Hana Bushara, to perform one of her songs on stage.



**Cellist Kate Kayaian** is known for her stunning artistry and for her passion for communicating through music. In addition to her solo touring and teaching, she performs and records regularly with such acclaimed ensembles as the GRAMMY nominated group Boston Modern Orchestra Project and has had the pleasure of working with some of the world's most celebrated music stars, including Jay-Z, Beyoncé, Alicia Keyes, Josh Groban, Peter Gabriel, and the Trans-Siberian.
